



Tamil University: Teaching-learning Process

Tamil University adopts systematic approach to the teaching-learning process. The syllabus of the programmes are periodically revised. Tamil University has adopted OBE system. All the programmes have Program Outcomes, Programme specific outcomes and course outcomes. Feed back is collected from the students, teachers, alumni and employers on the syllabus for revision.

Internal Assessment

Students write assignments, undertake fieldwork, and present in the class seminars. They also take periodic written tests. Students are assessed and guidance is offered to improve their skills.

Focus on Student Performance and skill

Students are encouraged to publish at the post graduate and graduate levels. They attend the seminar programmes and gain knowledge of the subject concerned.

Diversity of Learners

The programmes focus on the needs of various learners. Reading materials are offered for the students who need them. The focus is on both slow and advanced learners. Students raise questions through in the post-class sessions and they are addressed by the teachers.

Fieldwork

Field trips are arranged wherever necessary. Students visit industry environment for a better understanding of the subject.

Seminar and Workshops

Students participate in the seminars and they also engage in paper presentation.
